Page 4. Point 2. Technical specification, par. 2. Laptop computers TEMPEST NATO SDIP 27 Level A – 22 items, hyphen 10. instead of : “Minimum one-year warranty that can be verified on the manufacturer’s website via a serial number”, it should be:” Minimum one-year warranty that can be verified on the manufacturer’s website via a serial number, or by e-mail provided by bidder.”

Page 8. Bullet 2: Requirements concerning the due date and place of delivery, par. 2, instead of: “Contracting Authority’s premises”, it should be: “Supplier’s premises.”

Page 19. Point 8. instead of: “Not later than 12 months”, it should be:” Not shorter than 12 months.”

Page 25. Article 8, Par. 1, instead of “2%”, it should be:” 2‰”

Page 26. Article 10, Par. 3, after the word “location”, it should be put comma and words: “ in accordance with the Article 7. Par. 4.”

Page 27. Article 14, Par.3, instead of: “The present Contract shall be subject to and interpreted exclusively according to the regulations of the Republic of Serbia.” , it should be: “The present Contract shall be subject to and interpreted exclusively according to the regulations of the Country of the Supplier’s seat.”

Page 28, Article 14, Par. 5, instead of: “Should an amicable and extra-judicial settlement be impossible to reach, the Contracting Parties shall agree and confirm by their signatures that the settlement of the dispute shall be entrusted to the Belgrade Commercial Court.”, it should be: “Should an amicable and extra-judicial settlement be impossible to reach, the Contracting Parties shall agree and confirm by their signatures that the settlement of the dispute shall be entrusted to the competent Court of the Supplier’s seat.”
